Review of proposed referendum question:

Your Student Government Association would like to begin collecting between \$5-10\$ per year, a rate which would be set by the Student Senate, from your segregated fees to help partially subsidize a Childcare Center. This Center would be used by students, faculty and staff. Do you support this proposal?

Court approves the following provisions:

Binding Referendum

The Student Government Proposes to raise segregated fees by no more than \$10 to subsidize a Childcare Center available to students, faculty, and staff. Collection of this fee would begin in the 2015-16 academic year and continue of a rate of \$10 per year thereafter. Do you support this proposal?

Will this be a binding referendum?

It is recommended that the referendum be advisory rather than binding

Student Court's concern: Binding will not allow it to be overturned, if the outcome is that the referendum is declined. There is typically only a 10% of student voter turnout during elections.

Student Court Concern: How long would the referendum be binding for?
