

Online Training Now Available!

Crisis Response Training

The University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Center for Career Development and Employability Training (CCDET) along with the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, Division of Long Term Care, has developed a four-hour online dementia care training specific to crisis responders. Crisis responders represent any agency personnel that may be called upon when a person living with dementia appears to pose a danger to themselves or others. The cost of this training is \$60. Upon successful completion of this course, individuals will receive a certificate of completion and can also apply for CEUs. Additionally an online, public registry of dementia care trained crisis response personal will be implemented.
