Provost Area Policy and Procedures Base Salary Adjustments 2006-2007 Planning Process

After an informative discussion from the three guests concerning salary adjustments, it was agreed that it would be useful to begin a dialogue concerning generating clear principles for staff salary issues that could be used across campus.

Presently there are a number of different approaches and factors to salary adjustments that that are unique to individual departments and divisions. The ASC has asked that Sue, Kathy and Jan write up some items covering the issues and concerns that they face on a regular basis and ideas they have for principles that might be adopted and solutions that might be implemented.

The ASC is looking ahead to scheduling an Academic Staff forum (similar to the Faculty Forum) that will take place sometime in October. The ASC members are required, and any other academic staff member is encouraged, to send ideas for who we would like to have there to answer our questions.

Provost Hammersmith stated that in the future contract letters will be delivered in a more timely manner with the goal of having them delivered as near as possible to the 1st of July. She informed the group that although the pay increase is listed 2 percent, it is really 1.8 percent after you factor out the .2 percent that becomes part of the Chancellor's discretionary fund.

She reported that 27 academic staff were awarded equity adjustments using the portion of the Chancellor's that came from the academic staff pay plan. Six other equity adjustments were also made with internal funding.

Lucy asked that the Provost send an e-mail explaining the pay plan distribution, specifically explaining the 1.8% rather than the 2% that was in the state budget, and other factors that play a role in determining how much of a raise academic staff members receive.
