- 1. Minutes from the March 31<sup>st</sup> UC meeting were approved.
- 2. Mark Olkowski visited to discuss and solicit feedback for the UW-System committee, whose mission is to revise the Student Misconduct policy. This committee of ten members includes administrators, faculty, and system legal council. Their goal is to have a revised policy by the Fall 2023 semester. Mark asked the UC for advice on getting diverse feedback across campus and the UC advised that he meet with academic programs. UC members shared their experiences and frustrations in dealing with student misconduct.
- 3. Ryan Martin visited to solicit feedback on the General Education Realignment survey that will be sent to campus on April 15<sup>th</sup>. This UW-Green Bay committee will collect survey data, meet with units across campus, and begin working on a revised general education program with a goal of bringing a recommendation to Faculty Senate in two years. Constructive feedback was provided. Ryan requested time in the May 2022 Senate meeting to introduce the committee's mission and have a short listening session and the UC will provide this. Other options, such as a fall coffee break, for longer listening sessions were also recommended.
- 4. The UC approved the UC meeting/Faculty Senate schedule for the 2022-2023 academic year that was provided by SOFAS. Prior to a unanimous vote, a wise UC member stated, "I trust Steve (Meyer)."
