Bow Deer Hunting Application

The University of Wisconsin-Green Bay will be authorizing limited bow hunting for White-tailed Deer at the Point au Sauble Nature Preserve in Brown County during the 2008-09 hunting season. Hunters will be allowed to hunt by written permission only, subject to state regulations and special restrictions described below. The schedule for hunting will be assigned at 5:00, Monday, September 8, 2007. Applications will be accepted until 9:00 a.m. on September 8th. Hunters will be assigned weekly authorizations (Saturday-Friday) based on a lottery.

Hunters are encouraged to apply as a group of 3-5 people. Individual or dual applicants may be placed arbitrarily into groups with 1-3 other hunters, so that each date will be filled by a group of 3-5 hunters. *Applicants are eligible to apply only once, either as individuals or members of a group.* **(Note: Hunters may be asked for identification in the field; if an unauthorized person is using a permission note written to someone else, both that person and the person who provided the note will be permanently prohibited from hunting at the preserve.)**

Applicants whose names are selected in the lottery will be assigned to an available week (starting with preferred dates) until all weeks are filled. Each applicant is asked to provide 3 preferred dates. If all preferred dates are filled at the time of selection, the selected group will be assigned the nearest available open week. Note that 20 weeks will be available for hunting, following regulations for Zone 64M. Parts of two weeks (October 16-19 and December 11-14) have special restrictions for antlerless deer.

The following restrictions apply to hunting at Point au Sauble:

- Hunters are expected to respect adjacent private lands and to be aware of property boundaries (see attached map).
- Firearms are prohibited at all times.
- Marking, painting, or flagging of trees or other features is prohibited.
- **Only temporary deer stands or blinds (no nails or spikes in trees) are permitted; Your name must be affixed to the stand, and the stand must be removed at the end of the week. Violators will lose eligibility for all future hunting at Pt. Sauble.**
- No more than 5 hunters will be permitted on the property at any time (although 6 or more people may submit an application together).
- Hunters will need to accommodate birdwatchers, student researchers, and hikers, who also may use the preserve during the season. Bird studies and plant research will be ongoing during early fall.
- All other Wisconsin DNR hunting regulations apply.
