Academic basics: Definitions

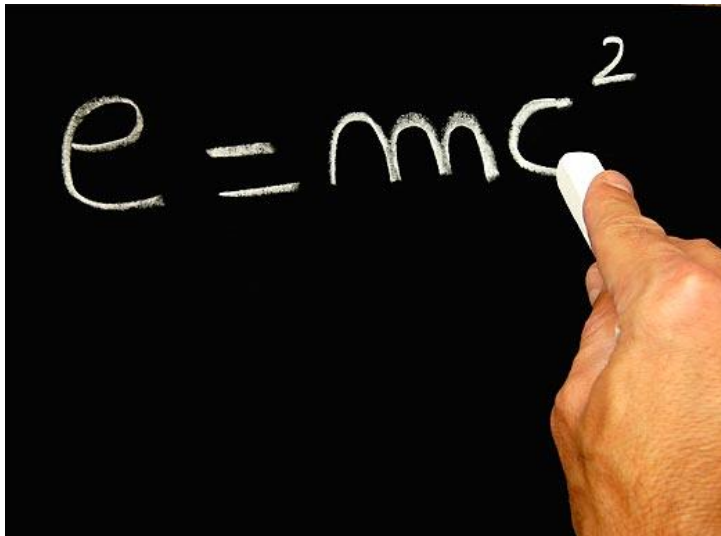
- Credit: A unit of academic progress
 - Typical class is 3 credits
- Degree: 120 credits, to include
 - General Education
 - Major/Minors/Electives
- Interdisciplinarity: The HALLMARK of UWGB's educational plan

Academic basics: General Education

- Purpose
- Requirements
 - Fine Arts – 3 credits
 - Humanities – 9 credits
 - Social Sciences – 9 credits
 - Natural Sciences – 10–12 credits
 - Ethnic Studies – 3 credits
 - World Culture – 3 credits



Academic basics: Math & Writing



- All students must satisfy English & Math competencies within 30 credits
 - AP or college courses may apply
- Writing Emphasis
- Advisor will discuss with you this afternoon

What you need to do TODAY

- Build a schedule of classes

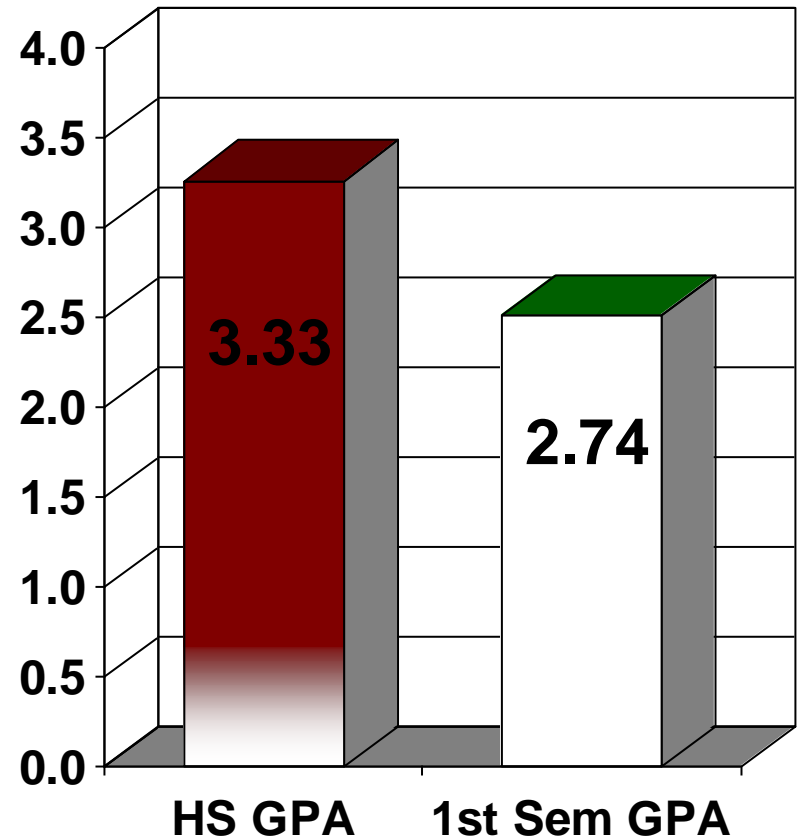

Looking forward: Grades

- What kind of grades do freshmen earn? A look at Fall 2010 class
 - On average, students DO NOT earn as high of a GPA in first semester at UWGB



Looking forward: Study time

- Classroom expectations & study time
- Example: 15 credits
 - 3 hours study/credit
 - $15 \text{ (credits)} \times 3 \text{ (study hours)} = 45 \text{ hours}$
 - $45 \text{ study hours} + 15 \text{ hrs in class} = 60 \text{ hrs}$
