Computing and Information Sciences
Take any 12 credits of Computer Science or Information Sciences.

Communication
Take any 12 credits of Communication.

Business

Take any 12 credits of Accounting, Business and/or Economics. One Communication course from (COMM 133, 200, 280) is permitted.

Fine and Performing Arts

Take any 12 credits of Art, Arts Management, Design or Theatre.

Arts & Music

Take any 12 credits of Music OR Music Applied, Music Ensemble OR Arts Management.

Natural Science

Take any 12 credits of Biology, Chemistry, Geoscience, Environmental Sciences, or Physics.

Human Biology

Take any 12 credits of Biology, Chemistry, Human Biology or Nutritional Sciences.

Social Sciences

(Individual focus within social sciences)

Take any 12 credits of Anthropology, Community Sciences, Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, Sociology, or Women Studies. (Note: For Education and Social Work, only the courses Education 206 and Social Work 250 have been approved as emphasis requirements).

Community Sciences

(Community focus within social sciences)

Take any 12 credits of Anthropology, Community Sciences, Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, Public and Environmental Affairs, Democracy and Justice Studies, Sociology or Urban and Regional Studies.

Humanities

Take any 12 credits of English, First Nations Studies, History, Humanistic Studies, Philosophy or foreign language. (The foreign language credits DO NOT include credits awarded retroactively).
