



# Art | 2014-2015 Assessment Plan

1. Which outcome will you assess?
  - Learning Outcome #5: “Ability to develop and defend an informed intellectual position.”
  - Studio Art Objective 2: Convey a stated concept through skillful use of materials and techniques.
2. Which technique will you use to assess this outcome?
  - The plan will be implemented through the senior show participants, collecting their scores on the artist statements (which we evaluate already) as the "stated concept" measure, and reviewing the success levels on that single aspect of the regular forms to determine whether or not this is something we need to work on as a group in 2015-2016.
3. Which course or group of students will you assess on the outcome chosen above and when?
  - Senior Show participants. This is not a required aspect of the Art degree, but is usually an option chosen by those seeking professional progress in Art beyond the undergraduate level (i.e. graduate school, gallery representation or other.)
4. Who will do the assessment and coordinate the data collection and reporting?
  - All full-time faculty will do the assessment and the executive committee will collect data (standard for determining Outstanding Senior Show.) Chair will report to the Office of Assessment.
