

## Human Development | 2014-2015 Assessment Plan

- 1. Which outcome will you assess?
  - Learning Outcome #3: Students will possess an understanding of the scientific methods involved in research on human development.
- 2. Which technique will you use to assess this outcome?
  - As a form of direct and embedded assessment we will be developing a rubric to assist us in analyzing student work submitted in Hum Dev 302 in Spring, including responses to final exam essay questions given in that course. A team of four faculty members will evaluate these responses and compare them to responses from students in a course of students, who have not taken Hum Dev 302. We revised learning outcomes for our Hum Dev 302: Developmental Research Methods during fall semester.
- 3. Which course or group of students will you assess on the outcome chosen above and when?
  - We will be conducting direct and embedded assessment in our core course Hum Dev 302 in Spring 2015.
- 4. Who will do the assessment and coordinate the data collection and reporting?
