Bird Banding Volunteer Assistant —Fall Owl Migration

Position Description:

Under the direct supervision of the Master Bander, Banding Volunteers will assist with: clearing brush and branches for mist net setup, setting up mist nets, monitoring nets for owls, removing owls from nets, removing leaves and small sticks from nets, closing and furrowing nets, measuring, weighing, and determining age and gender of owls, recording data, banding owls, and internet owl research. More than 98% of the owls captured will be Northern Saw-whet Owls.

Owl migration season is September 18 to November 15. Netting will be done nightly (weather permitting) from dusk until 1:00 am, with occasional later morning netting during peak migration.

Volunteers need to determine the schedule that works best for them, but each person needs to volunteer for at least 5 hr per week.

Banding Volunteers will not assist with other events, activities, or projects at Barkhausen Waterfowl Preserve nor will they be under the supervision of other Barkhausen staff. Experience will be limited to owl banding operations only.

Volunteers need to sign a Brown County Volunteer Form, have health insurance, and have had a tetanus vaccination within the past 10 years. Occupational hazards include: hands pierced by sharp talons, deer and wood tick bites, mosquito bites, and any and all infections and diseases that are associated with these hazards.

This is an unpaid position. UW-Green Bay students are encouraged to apply for the Great Lakes Higher Education Internship Grant or other grants for funding.

Personal Equipment Needed:

Rubber boots, warm clothes, personal head lamp and his/her own transportation to and from Barkhausen Waterfowl Preserve. Banding Volunteers need the mental, emotional and physical toughness to work outside and stay with a project through tough conditions. They must be able to go without food or using a cell phone for 4 hours and must strictly focus on banding.
