Program Overview

- **Emphasis** - Leadership
- **Length of Program** - 37 weeks
 - September to May
- **Hours** - 1,200 hours of practice experience
 - 32 hr./wk supervised practice (Mon-Th)
 - 6 hr. of didactic instruction and project management (F)
- **Breaks** - Scheduled over winter holidays

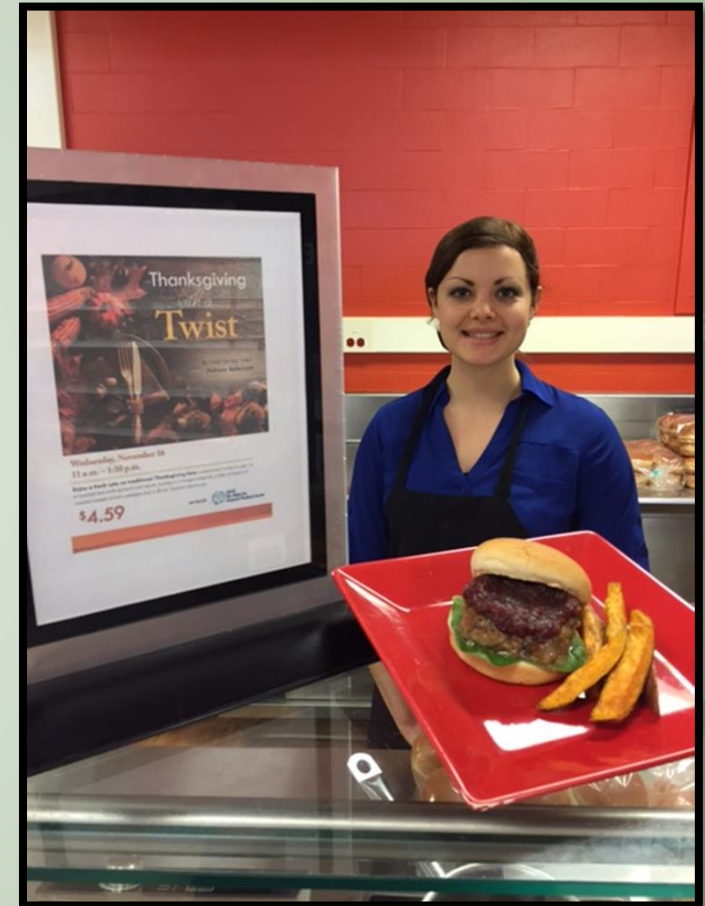
Rotations- Community

- **Community Wellness - 6 weeks**
- **Women Infants and Children (WIC) - 3 weeks**



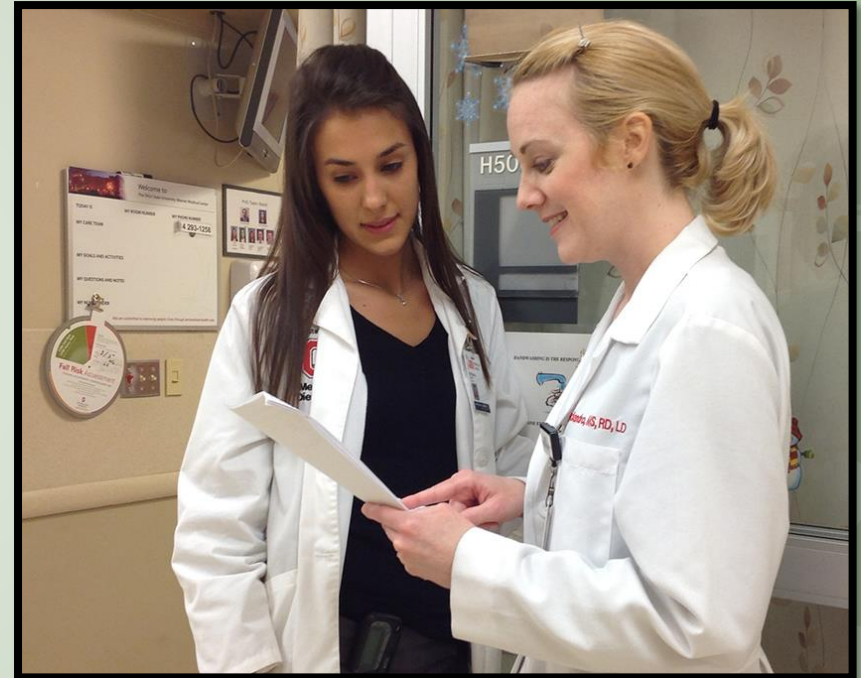
Rotations- Foodservice

- **School Foodservice:** 4-6 weeks
- **Hospital Foodservice:** 2-4 weeks



Rotations- Medical Nutrition Therapy (MNT)

- **Outpatient MNT**- 2 weeks
- **Long Term Care** - 3 weeks
- **Inpatient MNT** - 7 weeks
 - 2 additional weeks independent relief at incorporated MNT site



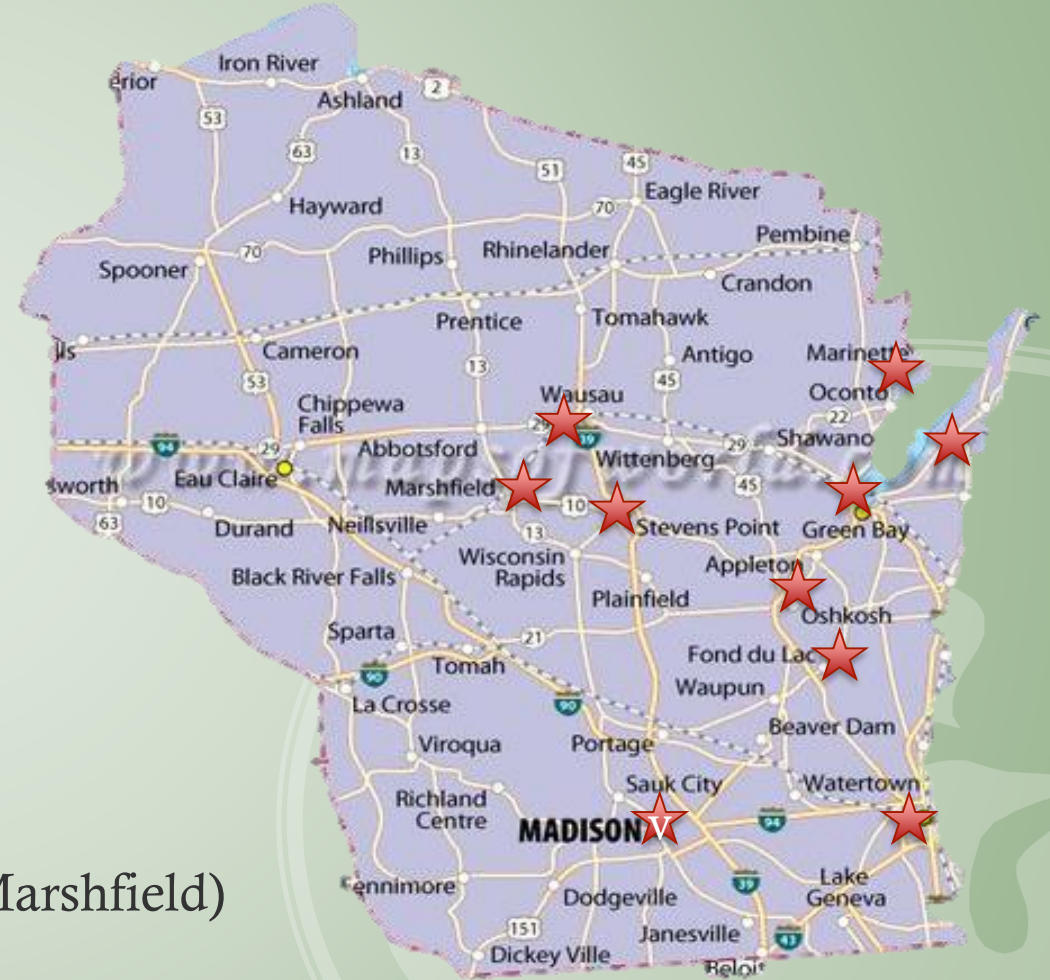
Rotations- Open

- **Open rotation - 2 weeks**
 - Determined by your personal preference in areas of dietetics
- **Prior Assessed Learning (PAL)** – May be eligible for time off based on prior professional experience

- 5-year first-time RDN exam pass rate - **96.7%**

Acceptance Criteria

Standard DICAS application process with 3 letters of recommendation

Required

- Baccalaureate or Masters degree from an accredited university
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Good written and verbal communication skills in English
 - TOEFL
 - IELTS

Criteria cont'd

Preferred

- Demonstrated ability (per the letters of recommendations and personal statement):
 - To work effectively as a member of a team/team leader
 - To be a self-directed and independent learner
 - To be flexible and enthusiastic
- Work and/or volunteer experience related to health care, community, and food service
- GRE: not required, but strongly recommended

Program Fees

- **Program Cost:** \$8663 (may change for 18-19 internship year)
- **DICAS Application:** \$40 first, \$20 each additional
- **UWGB Program Fee:** \$60 (non-refundable)
- **Additional Costs**
 - Housing: \$450-650 per month
 - Lab coats: ~ \$50
 - Books/Supplies: estimate \$400
 - Transportation: variable (**A vehicle is a must!**)
 - Student Membership: \$50 Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics
 - WAND meeting \$400
 - Other: \$150

Financial Supplementation

- **Financial Assistance:** Interns do not qualify for financial aid
 - Scholarships are available
- **Employment:** 10 hours maximum/week
