- Donors have announced their intention to make a substantive gift to the Retiree Association scholarship; the Committee decided it would be efficacious to send a letter to members with data about the status of the scholarship fund. Pat is providing a previous version, and Jacob will work up a draft. Attendant to this is the possibility of offering an estate planning information session for retirees.
