Position Acceptance

Of the 675 responses to "Did you accept your position prior to graduation?" 49.6 % noted they had accepted prior to graduation. Of those who had not accepted prior to graduation, 305 responses indicated accepting their position...

For the question "Is your position related to your major/program of study?" 82.3 % of the 536 responses indicated "Yes." (58.6 % were "Very Related" and 23.7 % were "Yes, Somewhat Related")

Geographic Location

Of the responses that identified the location of their employer (788 total), 86.3% are employed in Wisconsin. Twenty-seven (27) other states were reported, with 3.6% working in Minnesota, 1.6% in Illinois, and 1.1% in Michigan. Eight (8) alumni are working internationally including the countries of Portugal, Germany, Japan, Denmark, France, England, and Sweden.
