The University of Wisconsin Bachelor of Science in Health Information Management and Technology (HIMT) provides the skills you need to qualify for HIM and health IT jobs in today and tomorrow's technology-focused healthcare environments.

In the UW HIMT program, you will:

Who can apply?

You are eligible to apply if you have completed at least 60 credits of transferable general education coursework with a 2.0 or better GPA.

Accreditation and partnerships

Graduates of the CAHIIM-accredited management track are eligible to sit for the RHIA certification exam. UW HIMT is also a HIMSS Approved Education Partner and HIMSS Academic Organizational Affiliate. Graduates of the technology track are eligible to sit for the CAHIMS and CPHIMS certification exams.

UW HIMT students who plan to sit for certification exams receive test prep designed by credentialed faculty during the semester-long capstone prep course.
