## Travel Grant Application

The State of Wisconsin has established Study Abroad Travel Grants for Wisconsin residents who are full-time, undergraduate degree seeking students at UW– Green Bay and have established need as evidenced by information from the application for Financial Aid (FAFSA) for the current academic year. Students who are interested should complete this travel grant application and return it to the Office of International Education (OIE). For students traveling on Non-UWGB programs—you will need to submit a Consortium Agreement with the Financial Aid Office. The Director of Financial Aid in collaboration with the OIE will review the applications and the recipients will be notified by EMAIL of their eligibility.

### **Only applicants that meet the following requirements will be considered:**

- WI Residents enrolled as full-time, undergraduate degree seeking students at UW-Green Bay.
- Students who have applied and demonstrate financial need by submitting the applicable FAFSA form
- Students enrolled as a full time student in the semester preceding travel.
- Students participating in a long-term study abroad program (8 weeks in duration or longer) administered by UW-Green Bay or another UW-System institution, or National Student Exchange programs outside the 50 United States .
- Travel grants shall not be less than \$500 nor more than \$2000 per student
- Applicants who have not previously received a Travel Grant will receive funding priority

**Travel Grants will only be awarded if funding is available for the term of application.**
