 - Must be in original language AND English
 - Notarized copies are acceptable
 - Certification of degrees and dates granted**
 - *Example:* Diploma, Leaving Certificate, IGCSE, etc.
 - Must be in original language AND English
 - Notarized copies are acceptable
 - Transfer credits** from a foreign university
 - Must be evaluated through one of the recommended companies:
 - ECE (Educational Credential Evaluators): <http://www.ece.org/>
 - WES (World Education Services): <http://www.wes.org/>
 - Must purchase the “Course by Course” evaluation service
 - Evidence of English** (only one test required, must be sent to UWGB from testing source)**
 - 61 TOEFL IBT
 - 5.5 IELTS
- **Other evidence of English proficiency may be submitted in lieu of a TOEFL or IELTS score.
