- \$44.00 USD application fee**
- Official Transcripts**
 - Secondary School and/or University
 - Must be in original language AND English
 - Notarized copies are acceptable
- Official Diploma or Examination Results**
 - *Example:* Diploma, Leaving Certificate, IGCSE, etc.
 - Must be in original language AND English
 - Notarized copies are acceptable
- Transfer credits** from a foreign university
 - Must be evaluated by an evaluation service:
 - ECE <http://www.ece.org/>
 - WES <http://www.wes.org/>
 - “Course by Course” evaluation is required
- English Proficiency Testing** (only one test required, must be sent to UWGB from testing agency)**
 - 61 TOEFL IBT
 - 5.5 IELTS

**Other evidence of English proficiency can be submitted in lieu of a TOEFL or IELTS score.
