GE and elective can be flipped out based on student interest/desire (hence the similar color).

A minor or double major could go into the elective fields.

There is no "summer" course listed.

Only 5 more classes are needed for the student to minor in DESIGN ARTS. These classes include: DESIGN 131 Intro to Design Arts (S), DESIGN 331—Design Arts Studio I (S), DESIGN 332—Design Arts II (F). The remaining six credits required to complete the minor can be selected from a list of upper level electives that includes: DESIGN 433—Advanced Studio (F,S) with a choice of Multi-Media in Fall or Web Design in Spring. Note: Upper-level courses can not be double counted between the Art major and Design Arts minor

A double major in Art and Design Arts requires enrolling in an additional 27 credits with courses drawn from the Design Arts & English programs. With this double major no interdisciplinary minor is needed.
