- The 10 credit Design Core and corresponding Intro Studios are prerequisites for all upper-level studio courses
- A minimum of 9 credits must be taken from one studio area in addition to other relevant upper-level studio art courses to total 15 credits. Upper-level studio classes have a 300 or 400 designation.
