### **Description**

*The Federation of Environmental Technologists, Inc. (FET) is pleased to offer Scholarships of \$500 or more to students pursuing a degree in an Environmental field related to the management and prevention of air, water, and solid/hazardous waste pollution. FET will also award a \$1,000 Alan Haase Memorial Scholarship for a qualified student in the area of Environmental Health and Safety.*

Scholarship recipients will also be given free admittance to the FET 09 Annual Conference & Exhibition on October 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> (a \$375 value), membership in FET through June 30, 2010 (a \$115 value), and one free FET seminar offered during the year (a \$30 value).

### **Application Requirements and Information to Submit**

Eligible students must be currently enrolled in a field of study that relates to Environmental management, and may be in any year of study. Preference will be given on the basis of scholastic achievement. **Note:** *Previous FET Scholarship recipients are **ineligible** to apply. Those who have applied in the past and did not receive a FET Scholarship **are eligible** to re-apply.*

### **SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO BE CONSIDERED. Only one Application is needed for all categories of 2009 Scholarships:**

1. Applicant's name, address, telephone number, email address; also include a permanent mailing address if your current address is only through this school year
2. Name of college or other school at which the applicant is currently enrolled and year of study
3. Current field of study and courses taken to date relating to the Environmental field
4. Current grade point average and class standing
5. A statement of qualifications and career objectives including the environmental issues of interest to the applicant, and the role the applicant expects to play in addressing these issues (no longer than one page)
6. A summary of Financial Need (optional)
7. One or two Academic References with phone numbers to validate grade point average, class standing, and student aptitude for this field.
