## Student Gardens Manager

The student garden manager will provide an integrated hands-on learning experience managing a successful organic garden in the university union. The student must also take responsibility for the aesthetics of the Biodiversity Center's courtyard, showcasing Wisconsin native plants on the grounds.



### JOB DUTIES

- Maintains the gardens and courtyard by weeding, trimming, and watering. Must be flexible with the weather
- Manages, updates, and maintains a planting schedule so the gardens will always be in rotation.
- Weekly communication to the university about produce available.
- Ability to manage post-harvest handling. Conduct weekly or biweekly giveaway or sales with available produce when necessary.
- Submit garden donations to SUFAC and update organization members about the status of the garden, take pictures and publish pictures to the SLO facebook page.
- Thin plants in all courtyard beds and install new native species where applicable.
- Spray courtyard gravel with vinegar and salt solution to maintain proper appearance.
