

ALL CAMPERS:

- **Health Information:** You must bring the completed and signed "Health Information Form" to check-in. Participation will not be permitted without it.
- **Scuba Forms:** Please fill out the enclosed PADI Medical Statement and mail it back to us as soon as possible. If you marked yes to **ANY** of the medical history questions you must also complete Page 2 and have it signed by a physician to participate in the dive session. **If we do not receive your medical paperwork two weeks prior to the start of camp you are not guaranteed a position in the dive training.**
- **Class Hours:** Daily class hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Lunch hours are from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m. You will be given room and class schedules when you arrive.
- You may not leave the Camp premises at any time during the camp day. **PARKING:** Campers who bring a vehicle to camp are required to purchase a \$3 parking permit. The permit can be purchased at the Parking Office Hut (located inside the Main Entrance of campus) on the first day of camp.
- **Dress:** Casual, but appropriate summer attire is acceptable for camp sessions. Classrooms are air-conditioned, but campus housing is not. **TIP:** If you can't wear it to school, you can't wear it here.
- **Closing Ceremony:** An informal camper recap of the week will be presented from 3:00 p.m.—3:30 p.m. on Friday, July 31st in the Rose Hall Auditorium. Park in the Wood Hall Lot (Gold Lot). Campers are free to leave with their parents/guardians once the session concludes.

COMMUTER CAMPERS: (Campers who will be driving to campus each day)

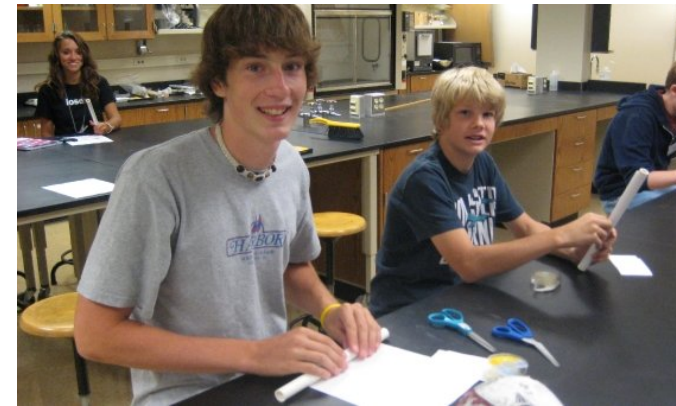
- **Check-In:** Check-in will be held from 8:00-8:30 a.m. on **Monday, July 27** in the **Wood Hall first floor cafeteria** (#10 on your map). Follow the directions for "A."
- **Directions:** Enter campus at the Nicolet Entrance onto South Circle Drive and take the first left onto Wood Hall Drive. This will bring you to the **Wood Hall Parking Lot (Gold Lot)**, which is adjacent to Wood Hall. The cafeteria is an open area that takes up most of the first floor. Please enter through the lowest doors of the building, near the loading dock area.

- **Meals:** Bring your own sack lunch or money to purchase food from vending machines. You will not be allowed to leave campus for lunch or at any other time during the day. Optional weekly lunch cards for the Cloud Commons cafeteria will be available for purchase at check-in Monday morning. Cost: \$35.
- Commuter campers are not allowed in the University Housing area.

RESIDENT CAMPERS: (Campers who will be staying in Campus Housing)

- **Check-In:** Check-in is from 3:00-4:00 p.m. on **Sunday, July 26**, in the University Union Phoenix Rooms. Please park in the adjacent visitor parking lot. See your map for directions (follow the signs for "B"). There you will obtain your room assignment and directions to your room. Arrival to and departure from the campus is the responsibility of the camper. Transportation is not provided from bus stations, airports, etc.
- **Housing Handbook:** You and your parent or guardian must read the enclosed Housing Handbook, which contains camp rules and regulations. It also provides information on what you should bring with you (fan, sheets or sleeping bag, towels, etc.).
- **First Meal:** Sunday dinner will be served in the University Union. Your Resident Counselor will show you where everything is located. Parents/Guardians are welcome to eat dinner with their camper after Sunday check-in. The cost of each all-you-can-eat meal will be approximately \$8.
- **Messages:** These can be left at the Head Counselor's Office at (920) 465-2742.

- **Evening/Special Events** are scheduled for Resident Campers from 6:30-9:30 p.m. each night and may include volleyball games, movies, pizza parties and/or field trips to various attractions around Green Bay such as Bay Beach Amusement Park and Miniature Golf. It is recommended that campers bring \$25-30 for snacks and activities.
- **Be sure to bring your swimming suit!** as we may be using the Kress Center pool for Buoyancy Training experiments on Friday.
- **Check-Out:** Campers should check-out after the final presentation on Friday afternoon, around 4:00 p.m. Parents/Guardians please meet your camper at their dorm room to properly check-out with their floor counselor. Check-out must be completed **before** 5:00 p.m. Friday. The Friday dinner meal is not included in your fees.
