

## ALL CAMPERS:

- **Health Information:** You must bring the completed and signed "Health Information Form" to check-in. Participation will not be permitted without it!
- **General Meeting:** A General Meeting is scheduled for 8:30 a.m. Monday in the Studio Arts cafeteria. **ALL CAMPERS MUST ATTEND AND BE ON TIME.** In the General Meeting, you will receive information regarding camp rules and regulations, an introduction to the week's activities, and be introduced to the camp staff. The instructors will then take their campers to their classrooms. Instructors will present the course projects and goals, and answer any camper questions.
- **Class Hours:** Daily classes are from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the Studio Arts Building. **\*NOTE:** The Art Show and Awards Presentation is scheduled from 3:00-4:00 p.m. in the Lawton Gallery. Campers will be dismissed by 4:00 p.m.
- You may not leave the Camp premises at any time during the camp day. **PARKING:** Campers who bring a vehicle to camp are required to purchase a \$3 parking permit. The permit can be purchased at the Parking Office Hut (inside the Main Entrance of campus) on the first day of camp.
- **Class Supplies:** A class supply list if not enclosed can be found on our Web site at [www.uwgbsummercamps.com](http://www.uwgbsummercamps.com).

- **Dress:** School-appropriate, comfortable, light-weight summer clothing. **Tip:** If you can't wear it to school, you can't wear it here. All classroom buildings are air-conditioned, although campus housing is not.
- **Final Exhibition and Awards:** Exhibition of artwork will be viewed by campers, faculty, parents/guardians, and friends on the Friday evening of camp each week at 3:00 p.m. in the Lawton Gallery located on the second floor of Theatre Hall. Awards will be juried by the SAS staff members and all award winning art will be identified by a certificate posted adjacent to the art. The Art Show will conclude at 4:00 p.m. Course subject matter will be appropriate to the artist's age and experience. Lewd, offensive or obscene artwork will not be displayed in the exhibition.

Congratulations on your acceptance to the UW-Green Bay Summer Art Studio Camp! This information letter and packet should be kept for reference. No other information will be sent prior to your arrival at camp. Please share this letter with your parent or guardian. **Note:** Enclosed with this letter is a receipt confirming your payment and any balance due. Balance **must** be paid by June 12 (Middle School) or June 19 (High School). You may call in a payment with a credit card to 800-892-2118 or send a check to the Summer Camps Office.

### **COMMUTER CAMPERS: (Campers who will be driving to campus each day)**

- **Check-In:** Check-in will be held in the Studio Arts Building cafeteria from 7:45-8:30 a.m. on **Monday morning, June 15 (Middle School) or June 22 (High School).** Please see your map for directions (follow the directions for "C").
- **Parking:** Follow the signs to the **Studio Arts Lot (Blue Lot).** The cafeteria is on the first floor of the Studio Arts Building, adjacent to the Studio Arts Lot.
- **Meals:** Bring a sack lunch daily or money to purchase food from vending machines. A supervised lunch period will be provided in the Studio Arts cafeteria. An additional option to purchase weekly lunch cards will be available at Monday check-in for the cost of \$35. All campers with lunch cards will eat in the Cloud Commons cafeteria on campus. **It is prohibited to leave the campus for lunch or any other time during the day.**

- Commuter campers are not allowed in the University Housing area.
- **\*NOTE:** Campers are dismissed after the Art Show on Friday, at 4:00 p.m.

### **RESIDENT CAMPERS: (Campers who will be staying in campus housing)**

*Middle School (June 15-19)*

*Day Camp Only-Resident Option Not Available*

*High School (June 21 - June 26)*

- **Check-In:** Check-In is held in the University Union Phoenix Rooms from 3:30-4:15 p.m. on **Sunday, June 21.** Park in the adjacent visitor lot. Please see your map for directions (follow the directions for "B"). There you will receive your room assignment and directions to your room. Arrival to and departure from the campus is your responsibility. Transportation is not provided from bus stations, airports, etc.
- **Housing Handbook:** You and your parent or guardian must read the enclosed Housing Handbook, which contains camp rules and regulations. It also provides information on what you should bring (sheets or sleeping bag, towels, etc.).

### **Both Sessions:**

- **First Meal:** Sunday dinner will be the first meal for each session. Both will be served in the Cloud Commons cafeteria, located in the University Union. Your Resident Counselor will show you where everything is located. Parents/Guardians are welcome to eat dinner with their camper after Sunday check-in and/or before the exhibition on Friday. The cost of each all-you-can-eat meal is around \$7-\$8 per person.

- **Messages:** These can be left at the Head Counselor's Office at (920) 465-2742.
- **Evening/Special Events:** These are scheduled for Resident Campers each night from 6:30-9:30 p.m. and may include volleyball games, movies, pizza parties, dances and/or field trips to various attractions around Green Bay such as Bay Beach Amusement Park and Miniature Golf. It is recommended that campers bring \$25-\$30 for snacks and activities.
- **Check-Out:** It is best to check-out after the Art Show. Meet your son/daughter at the Art Show at 3:00 p.m.. After the show, drive to the Residence Life area to pack up and check-out of your room, between 4:00—4:30 p.m. All campers must be checked out by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 26.
