

ALL CAMPERS:

- **Health Information:** You must bring the completed and signed "Health Information Form" to check-in. Participation will not be permitted without it!
- **General Meeting:** A General Meeting is scheduled for 8:30 a.m. Monday in the Studio Arts Cafeteria. **ALL CAMPERS MUST ATTEND AND BE ON TIME.** In the General Meeting, you will receive information regarding camp rules and regulations, an introduction to the week's activities, and be introduced to the camp staff. The instructors will then take their campers to their classrooms. Instructors will present the course projects and goals, and answer any camper questions.
- **Class Hours:** Daily classes are from 8:30-4:00 in the Studio Arts Building. On Friday, campers will be dismissed from the Final Exhibition Art Show at 4:00pm.
- You may not leave the Camp premises at any time during the camp day. **PARKING:** **Campers who bring a vehicle to camp are required to submit their license plate number at check-in.** This will be given to Public Safety officers as your "parking pass" on campus. Failure to report your plate number will result in a ticket. Do not park in 15-minute or loading zones.
- **Class Supplies:** A class supply list can be found on our website at www.uwgbsummercamps.com. Supplies can be purchased in an art store in your city or by ordering in advance through Tradewind Products III at 920-432-1270; email: tradewinds@tds.net

- **Dress:** School-appropriate, comfortable, light-weight summer clothing. **Tip:** If you can't wear it to school, you can't wear it here. All classroom buildings are air-conditioned, although campus housing is not.
- **Final Exhibition and Awards:** Exhibition of artwork will be viewed on the Friday afternoon of each camp week at 3:00PM in the Lawton Gallery located on the 2nd floor of **Theatre Hall**. Awards will be juried by the Camp staff and all award winning art will be identified by a certificate posted adjacent to the art. The Art Show will conclude with awards at 4:00 p.m. **FASHION CAMPERS** will have their Fashion Show at the beginning of the Final Art Show beginning at 3:00PM.
- Course subject matter will be appropriate to the artist's age and experience, as determined by camp staff.

Congratulations on your acceptance to the UW-Green Bay Summer Art Studio Camp! This information letter should be kept for reference. No other information will be sent prior to your arrival at camp. Please share this letter with your parent or guardian. You should have received a receipt confirming your payment and any balance due. Balance **must** be paid by June 4 (Middle School) or June 11 (High School). You may call in a payment with a credit card to 920-465-2775 or send a check to the Summer Camps Office.

COMMUTER CAMPERS:

Campers who will be commuting to campus each day.

- **Check-In:** Check-in will be held in the **Studio Arts Building** cafeteria from 7:45-8:30 a.m. on **Monday morning, June 18 (Middle School) or June 25 (High School)**. Please see your map for directions (follow the directions for "C").
- **Parking:** Follow the signs to the **Weidner Center Parking Lot**. The Studio Arts Building is adjacent to the Weidner Center Parking Lot.
- **Meals:** Bring a lunch daily or money to purchase food from vending machines. You may purchase a weekly lunch card to eat in the Cloud Commons cafeteria at Monday check-in for the cost of \$40. You can also pay cash daily in the cafeteria for \$8.00 per meal. **It is prohibited to leave the campus for lunch or any other time during the day.**
- Commuter campers are not allowed in the University Housing area.
- ***NOTE:** Campers will be dismissed after the Art Show on Friday, at 4:00 p.m.

RESIDENT CAMPERS:

Campers who will be staying in campus housing

- **Check-In:** Check-in is held in the **Hendrickson Center** from 2:00-4:15 p.m. on **Sunday, June 24**. Follow the directions for "B" on your campus map. There you will receive your room assignment and directions to your room. **Arrival to and departure from the campus is your responsibility.** Transportation is not provided from bus stations, airports, etc.
- **Housing Handbook:** You and your parent or guardian must read the Camp Housing Handbook, which contains camp rules and regulations. It also provides information on what you should bring with you to camp (sheets or sleeping bag, towels, etc.).
- **First Meal:** Sunday supper will be the first meal available for resident campers. It will be served in the Cloud Commons cafeteria, located in the University Union. Your Resident Counselor will show you where everything is located. Parents/Guardians are welcome to eat supper with your camper after Sunday check-in and/or before the exhibition on Friday. The cost of each "all you can eat" meal is \$8.00 per person.

Both Sessions:

- **Messages:** These can be left at the Head Counselor's Office at (920) 465-2742.
- **Evening/Special Events:** These are scheduled for Resident Campers each night from 6:30-9:30 p.m. and may include volleyball games, movies, pizza parties, dances and/or field trips to various attractions around Green Bay such as Bay Beach Amusement Park and Miniature Golf. It is recommended that campers bring a minimum of \$25-\$30 for snacks and activities.
- **Check-Out:** It is best to check-out after the Art Show. Meet your son/daughter at the Art Show at 3:00 p.m. After the show, drive to the Residence Life area to pack up and check-out of your room, between 4:00-4:30 p.m. All campers must be checked out by 5:00 p.m. on Friday.
