

GOING GREEN IDEAS: DID YOU KNOW?



Marigolds are the best deterrent for cut worms, rabbits & pesky moths that want to lay their eggs on your plants. Grow marigolds all along your garden borders. When the season is done, cut those plants then dry & store.

Marigold bug spray:

This applies to fresh marigolds or dried marigolds that you pick at the end of the season, dry & store in a Ziploc bag for the following season.

Boil 2 quarts of water in a pot.

After water boils, add the marigolds, stems & all. Boil for 3 minutes.

Turn off heat & cover pot & let it sit for ½ hour.

Strain the marigolds discard them. You now have a great batch of bug repellent.

Put this liquid in a pump spray bottle & spray veggie & flowering plants.

Remember, each time it rains, you will have to reapply your spray.
