**You must meet one of the following State
recommendations for prioritization of the H1N1 vaccine
to receive vaccine on campus at this time:**

- Pregnant women
- Persons who live with or provide care for infants age 6 months or younger (examples: parents, siblings, daycare providers)
- Health-care and emergency medical services personnel who have direct contact with patients or infectious material
- Children aged 6 months - 4 years
- Children and adolescents aged 5-18 who have chronic medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications.
- All persons aged 19-64 who have underlying medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications.

Examples of underlying medical conditions; but not limited to:

Diabetes

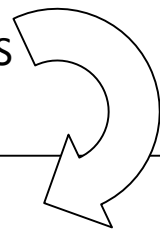
Cardiovascular disease

Cancer

Asthma or other chronic pulmonary disease
