Be a Good Neighbor.

Know your neighbors.

- Introduce yourself.
- Show interest - greet neighbors.
- Appreciate and respect community lifestyles.

Be Responsible.

- Take care of pets.
- Watch noise levels.
- Be responsible for guests' behavior.

Keep your neighborhood clean.

- Keep indoor furniture inside.
- Pick up trash and garbage.

Be a Good Citizen.

Read the entire lease.

It is a binding legal contract.
Ask your landlord if you have questions.

Wisconsin laws require you to recycle.

Green Bay City Ordinances prohibit:

- Parking on the lawn
- Parking blocking the sidewalk
- Overnight street parking
- Parking on the street during a snow emergency
- More than 3 unrelated persons living together in single family house

Be Safe.

Property

- Keep your doors and windows locked.
- Keep valuables in a safe place.
- Lock your vehicle at all times.
- Don't label your keys or hide spares in an easy to find place.

Self

- Avoid walking alone.
- Walk in well-lit areas.
- Know the names and phone numbers of your neighbors in case of an emergency.
