

## GRADUATE ASSISTANT PROPOSAL FORM

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

All departments (or individual faculty) must notify the Office of Graduate Studies (OGS) of Graduate Assistantship (GA) need each academic year. To qualify for fringe benefits, GA positions must be between 13.5 and 20 hours per week\*, and a minimum of one full semester. Exceptions for fewer hours will be considered. All students must apply through the OGS each academic year to ensure eligibility before hire. Faculty and staff should not promise positions to students based on past allocation or hire.

Please complete this form and email to gradstu@uwgb.edu. With the exception of individual grant-funded positions, proposals for GA support are **due annually by March 15** for positions beginning the following academic year.

Example: This GA will run two Chemistry labs each semester under the guidance of a faculty supervisor. Most labs are "guided" experiences and the GA will participate in a lab before running on their own. Must have completed 2 undergraduate Chemistry courses with labs and earned a grade of B or better. GA will maintain lab safety protocols and support undergraduate student learning.

## GRADUATE ASSISTANT REQUIREMENTS

GA positions are competitive and contingent on funding. Eligibility requirements include:

- Admitted in full academic standing to a UW-Green Bay graduate degree program
- Enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits each semester, and no fewer than 15 credits each academic year (special exceptions can be made for doctoral and MSW part-time students.
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA in graduate degree coursework
