The University of Wisconsin-Green Bay (UWGB) announces a program of Graduate Research Assistantships for students pursuing the Master of Science degree in Environmental Science and Policy (ES&P). The purpose of these Graduate Research Fellowships is to provide outstanding research experience for developing professionals in the fields of environmental science, and environmental policy and administration.

Each recipient will conduct research under the supervision on an ES&P faculty member for an average or at least 20 hours per week throughout the award period, and this research will be the basis for the recipient's master's thesis.

Each Fellow will receive an annual stipend equal to that of a TA position plus benefits.

Assistantships are awarded on a competitive basis. Recipients must:

- Be enrolled in or accepted into UWGB's Master of Science program in Environment Science and Policy (ES&P).
- Have outstanding potential for scholarship and research in the area of environmental science or environmental policy.
- Pursue an emphasis within the ES&P program in Resource Management, Ecosystems Studies, or Environmental Policy and Administration.

Assistantship recipients are selected on a competitive basis by a committee of ES&P faculty. The selection committee will include representatives of the three emphases (Resource Management, Ecosystems Studies, or Environmental Policy and Administration) and may not include the thesis advisor of any applicant.

**Deadline for applications is March 15th, 2011. Applicants should submit the following to the Office of Graduate Studies at UW-Green Bay, RH 305, 2420 Nicolet Drive, Green Bay, WI 54311-7001, c/o ES&P Program Chair:**

1. a letter of interest including the applicant's contact information
2. undergraduate transcripts
3. transcripts of any graduate work completed
4. GRE scores
5. 3 letters of recommendation
6. ES&P program applicants must submit a statement of research interest; students already enrolled in the ES&P program must submit their thesis statement.
