III. Annual Basis

Faculty and academic staff on an annual basis will be paid in the traditional manner with pay dates beginning the 1st of the month following the month of service. If the first falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the pay day is the preceding Friday as shown above, with the exception of January 1 check, which must be paid in January.
