Scholarship Description

In recognition of his retirement in the spring of 2006, Professor Emeritus Kenneth Fleurant's family made a gift of \$1,000 in his name to be used for student scholarships. Prof. Fleurant has always been grateful for the financial support he received while a college student and the family felt this was a wonderful way to recognize his work and contributions to UW-Green Bay. Professor Fleurant was awarded the title Professor Emeritus in spring of 2006. A member of the UW-Green Bay faculty since 1970, he taught in the French and humanistic studies academic units. Ken's wife Paula earned her undergraduate degree from UW-Green Bay in 1975 and her master's from UW-Green Bay in 1986. Her career focused on the healthcare industry and included assignments at St. Mary's Hospital and St. Vincent Hospital in Green Bay. Paula was also recognized as a Distinguished Alumni Award recipient in 2009 by the UW-Green Bay Alumni Association.

One \$500 and one \$505 scholarship will be awarded (2 total).

Eligibility and Requirements

- Must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in good standing at UW-Green Bay (must complete 12 credits in Spring 2017).
- Must be participating in a UW-Green Bay sponsored short-term summer university program (not a travel course)
- Preference given to language majors or minors participating in a language immersion program
- Completed short answer questions (below)
- Finalists will complete a short interview with the selection committee
- Please submit application form and essay by EMAIL to ois@uwgb.edu by the deadline

Answer the questions below in 1-2 page typed document. Please include your name and email address on each page.

- *Why do you want to go abroad and why did you choose this program?*
- *Have you been abroad before? If so, describe your previous experiences.*
- *How are you planning to fund your study abroad program? What are obstacles to this?*
- *Tell the scholarship committee something you want them to know about yourself.*
- *What is one challenge that you face in either choosing or participating in a study abroad program?*

Deadlines for submission is MARCH 24th. Interviews for finalists will be scheduled March 28th – 31st.
