## **Kress Events Center DISCLAIMER POLICY**

The Kress Events Center staff will use positive methods of discipline which include self-control, respect for others, cooperation and self-direction. When children display inappropriate behavior, warnings and timeouts may be issued. If students continue to have problems, the parents, student, swim instructor and program director will discuss solutions to the problem at hand. In severe cases of discipline, loss of privilege and/or removal from class or the program may result.

We will work with you and your child to ensure that solutions are agreed upon and behavior is corrected. We encourage all students to follow all program rules as outlined in the Class Policies found on page three of this booklet and avoid inappropriate behavior. Inappropriate behavior may include the following but is not limited to:

- Destroying or taking property of the facility, students or staff;
- Disrespect, rudeness, or discourtesy to others;
- Causing physical or emotional harm to others;
- Out of control behavior such as inappropriate touching.

Students who fail to follow established rules may be dismissed from the program for the day or the next scheduled class day. Students who are removed from a program for bad behavior or other problems will not be eligible for a refund. Students who have been removed from the program will not be allowed reentry into the Learn to Swim Program.
