SMALL PROJECTS, LARGE PROJECTS: BOTH ARE BEING SOUGHT

Up to \$35,000 will be awarded to support projects in the 2010-2011 fiscal year. The scope of projects will vary, too, with consideration given to classroom-specific as well as multi-school or multi-district collaborations. Whatever the budget and scope of your project, a team-based approach is encouraged.

Here is the likely breakdown of funding allocations:

Under \$1,500	10-15 projects	\$3,000-\$5,000	3-5 projects
\$1,500-\$3,000	4-9 projects	\$5,000-\$7,500	1-3 projects

All teachers, administrators, and other professionals affiliated with CESAs 7 and 8 participating in the Institute for Learning Partnership are eligible to apply. While collaborations are encouraged, a single entity (school, school district, etc.) must be designated as the fiscal agent.

We want you to be successful with your application and we want to help. So, UW-Green Bay faculty will offer two workshops about Action Research which is integral in planning your grant. The workshops are scheduled for:
