Common Grounds Coffeehouse (opens at 10:00 a.m.)

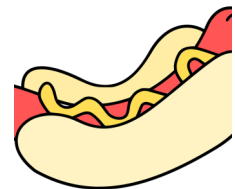
- Serving coffee, tea, soda and a variety of baked goods and sandwiches
