Take Hwy. 57 to Sturgeon Bay, then follow exit Bus. 42/57 to downtown. As you cross over the downtown bridge you'll see Stone Harbor Resort to your left on 1000 feet of scenic waterfront.

**From U.S. Highway 41:** Take Interstate 41 to Hwy172. Take 172 east to Interstate route 43 to Sturgeon Bay. Follow to 43 take that to 54/57 to Sturgeon Bay / Algoma, follow 57 north 40 minutes to business 42/57 follow over Sturgeon Bay Bridge **Stone Harbor Resort** is located on the left.

**From the Fox Cities:** Take Interstate 41 to Hwy172. Take 172 east to Interstate route 43 to Sturgeon Bay. Follow to 43 take that to 54/57 to Sturgeon Bay / Algoma, follow 57 north 40 minutes to business 42/57 follow over Sturgeon Bay Bridge **Stone Harbor Resort** is located on the left.

**From Madison, Wisconsin:** Take route 151 East to 26 (**not the Waupan exit**) to Oshkosh and interstate 41. Take Interstate 41 to Hwy172. Take 172 east to Interstate route 43 to Sturgeon Bay. Follow to 43 take that to 54/57 to Sturgeon Bay / Algoma, follow 57 north 40 minutes to business 42/57 follow over Sturgeon Bay Bridge **Stone Harbor Resort** is located on the left.

**From Milwaukee, Wisconsin:** Take Interstate route 43 to Sturgeon Bay. Follow to 43 take that to 54/57 to Sturgeon Bay / Algoma, follow 57 north 40 minutes to business 42/57 follow over Sturgeon Bay Bridge **Stone Harbor Resort** is located on the left.
