Diana is a strong mentor for individuals entering the field of Social Work, and has been teaching and providing supervision for social work students since 1992.

Workshop Learning Objectives:

1. Participants will be able to identify their own strengths as supervisors and understand how to use these strengths effectively with their supervisees.
2. Participants will be able to identify components of a strength based, collaborative model of supervision.
3. Participants will be able to identify ethical issues in supervision and have a clear understanding of boundaries in supervision.
4. Participants will learn how to address common issues which may arise with supervisees. (i.e. value conflicts, joining, pacing, dealing with intensity)
5. Participants will participate in role play scenarios to practice new skills and to discuss multiple ways of addressing supervisory issues.
