

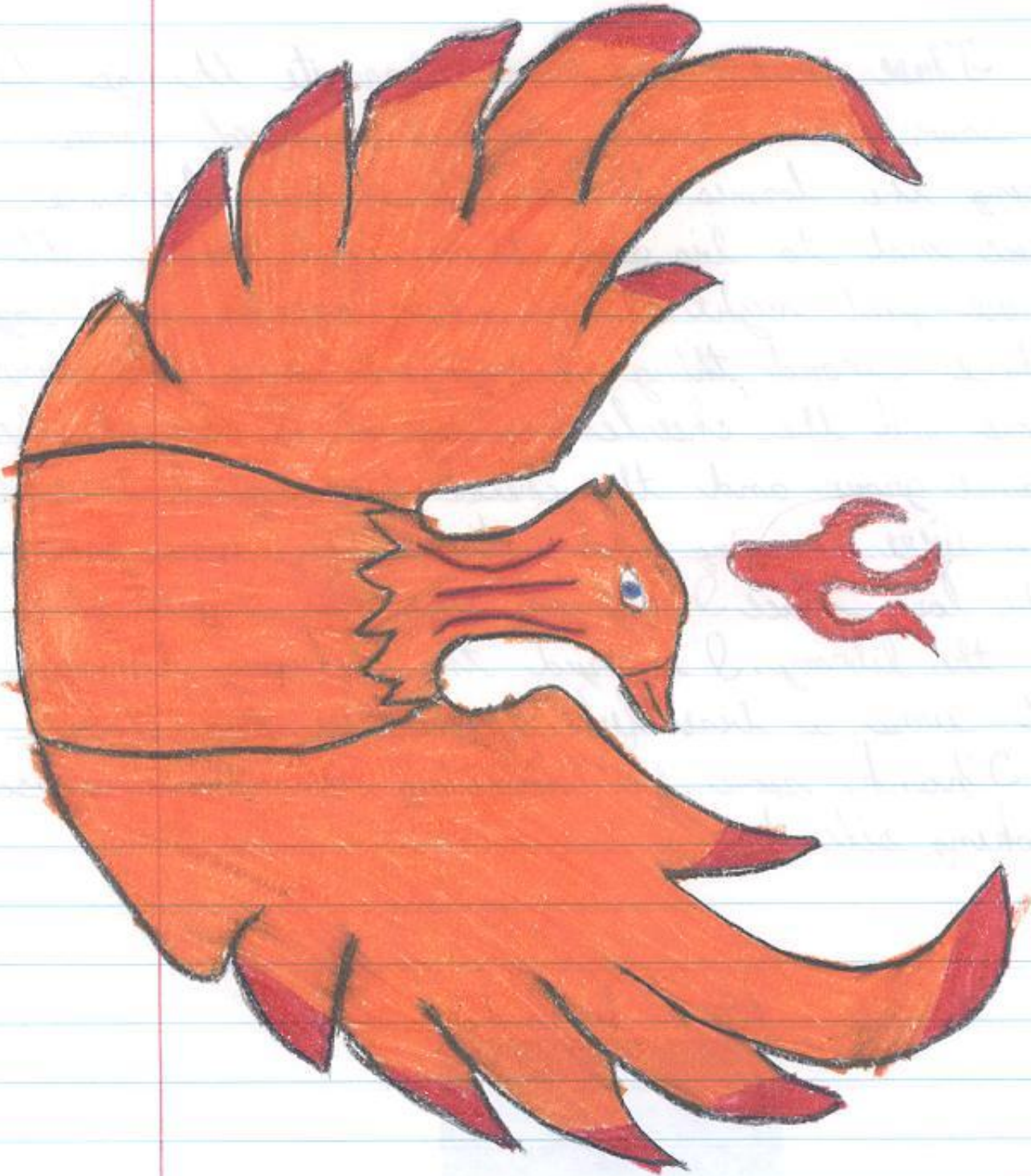
Dear, Ms. Desotell,

My most favorite part was walking with my romodle Jessica. She was so fun and cool.

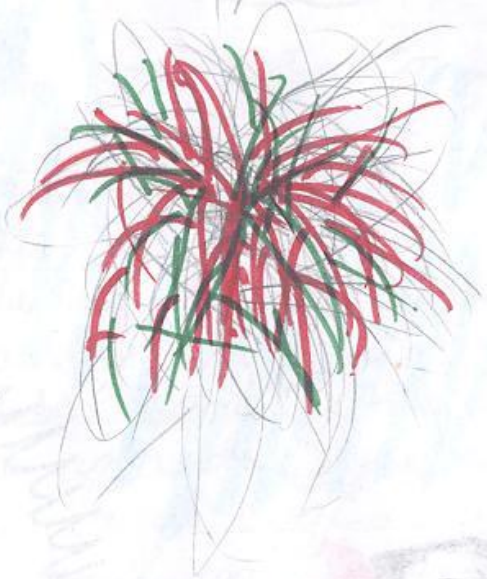
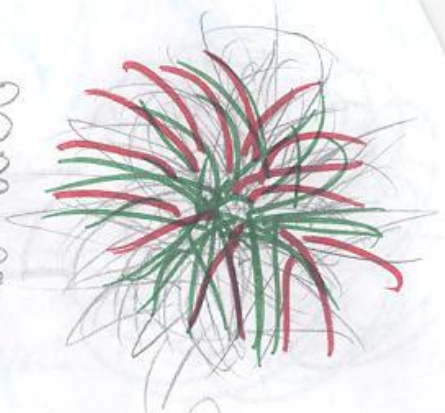

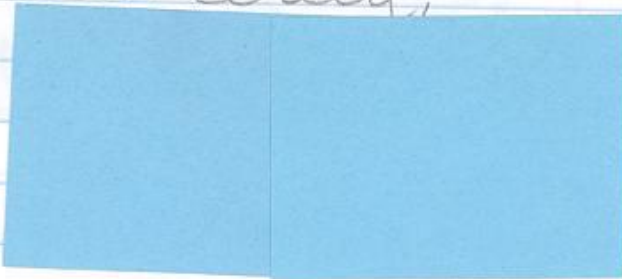


Dear Mrs. Desotell,

Dear Joe Phuture Phoenix Guide,


When I heard I was coming to the school, I was incredibly happy and excited! 😊 I couldn't wait to get on the bus.

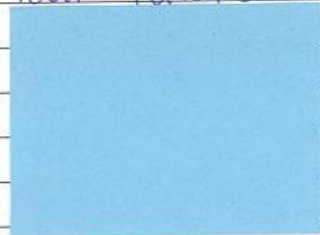
Dear Phuture Phoenix,

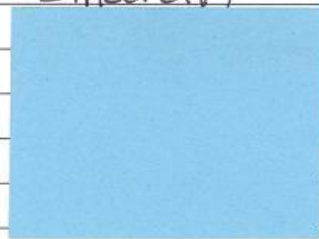
Dear Phuture Phoenix,
