REVOCATION OF GRANTS AND CONTRACTS POLICY

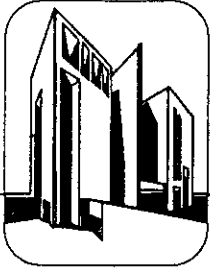
On September 1, 1993, the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay set a policy that indirect costs could be waived on all grants and contracts funded by the State of Wisconsin and/or local municipalities. This policy was based on UW-Madison, Research Administration-Financial NOTICE 87-6 and applied to State GPR and non-GPR funds.

The UW System General Administrative Policy Paper #2 - Financial Administration of Extramural Support states that indirect costs for non-federal grants and contracts must be included at the federally negotiated rates currently in effect. If the sponsoring agency has an indirect cost rate which is less than the federal rate, the University will consider accepting that rate only after a review to determine if it is (1) a published rate, and (2) an agency-wide policy, and (3) consistently applied by that organization to all of its outside grants and contracts with educational institutions.

In compliance with GAAP #2, the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay will require the inclusion of indirect costs on ALL grants and contracts, including those entered into with other Wisconsin state agencies. State funding source does not affect this policy.

GRANTS AND CONTRACTS POLICY

RE: Indirect Cost Charges On State of WI and Local Municipality Funding

Until further notice, indirect costs may be waived on all grants and contracts funded by the State of Wisconsin and/or local municipalities. This notice is based on UW-Madison, Research Administration-Financial NOTICE 87-6 and applies to State GPR and non-GPR funds.

Pass-through Federal funding (except as provided otherwise by Federal regulations) must include indirect costs at the federally negotiated rate currently in effect.

The financial administration of extramural support is governed by GAPP #2, which states that to accept any rate less than the federally negotiated rate, it should be demonstrated to the Chancellor or delegated designee that a project is of sufficient importance to warrant subsidizing the indirect costs from other university programs.
