The Rolfe B. White Scholarship is awarded to students who have a significant investment in strengthening their professional work on behalf of low-income people. This scholarship is available to social work students who will be seniors in the coming fall semester. Applications for the Rolfe B. White Scholarship Fund are evaluated based on submission of typed materials addressing the following criteria:

- 1) Documentation demonstrating your good academic standing in the Social Work Program.
- 2) Explain why you believe that addressing poverty issues is integral in social work practice.
- 3) Discuss approaches that you believe would be successful in reducing poverty among social work clients.
- 4) Discuss how you will work to reduce impact of poverty on clients when you find employment as a social worker after graduation.
