Don't worry; here are some suggestions and advice from the teacher panel:

- During your student teaching, try to find a teacher that has teaching methods the same or similar to yours for experience.
- Get to know the principal where you student teach by inviting them into your classroom, they will be one of your biggest assets to getting a job right away.
- Take the opportunity to observe other classrooms while student teaching.
- Ask for multiple Letters of Recommendation and select the top 3 to send in with your resume.
- Make sure that the Letters of Recommendation are on letterhead and high quality copies.
- Ask for a digital copy of each Letter of Recommendation and keep the original hard copy in your portfolio.
- If you have the chance to substitute for a teacher, leave the teacher helpful notes indicating what material was covered, whether the class behaved well or not, and what was accomplished for the day.
