- Rising Junior, Senior, or Graduate Student
- Interest in aerospace or space-related fields

Application Packet:

- Cover letter (include mention of 2009 Summer Program)
- Resume
- Unofficial transcript
- Two letters of faculty reference

IMPORTANT: JPL engineers and scientists will review your packet and select students that match JPL projects. If selected by JPL, WSGC will require an interview with the selected candidate. JPL/WSGC selected candidates may be eligible for funding through the Wisconsin Space Grant Consortium and/or JPL.
