- Possible to complete your BSW degree in 2 years of full-time study;
- Part-time options available for working families

Course Transfer Conditions:

- This transfer plan does not guarantee admission to the UWGB Social Work program. Students must apply and be accepted to the UWGB Social Work in order to pursue the BSW degree.

- Students choosing a major other than Social Work will have different and/or additional requirements to complete.
- NTC courses taken outside of the Human Services degree program will be evaluated on a course by course basis.
