Tax rolls are **not indexed**; they are arranged by legal description (parcel number, section number, lot/block number, etc) within each township. Our holdings vary greatly by county and city/town/village. Please check the back of this form for specific information on county holdings. After 1900, only those years ending in 0 and 5 are in our collections.

\$10.00 for copies of 1 to 3 separate tax rolls (Additional tax rolls are an additional \$3.00 each) **NOTE:** each year generally represents a different tax roll.

Your request will be processed within 4 weeks. If you require same-day or next-day service, a \$10 rush fee will apply. This rush service is subject to availability.
