



# Health Information Management Technology | 2015-2016 Assessment Report

1. Please give a brief overview of the assessment data you collected this year.

The learning outcome reviewed for 2015-2016 was Graduates of the HIMT program will have the knowledge and skills necessary to “Manage the collection, reporting, and storage of data”.

To assess this outcome, student achievement of Lesson 6 in HIMT 300 was reviewed. The student learning objective was –

- Upon completing this lesson you will be able to:
  - Design reports.
  - Design screens.

The assessment outcome selected was –

Student grades on this lesson will be reviewed. The goal is that at least 95% of the students in the fall 2015 HIMT 300, sections 1 & 2, get a grade of 70% or better.

While the initial goal included only a review of grades in the fall of 2015 semester, the course was added to the spring 2016 semester, so data from that session was also included.

In the fall 2015 session, there were 2 sections of the course, with a total enrollment of 38 students. 3 students did not complete the assignment. Of the students completing the assignment, 100% scored 70% or better, with a range of 85-100.

2. How will you use what you’ve learned from the data that was collected?

HIMT 300 is up for course revision in 2016, with the revised content to begin running in fall 2016. This information will be taken into consideration in the revision. One related goal of the revision is to strengthen the use of healthcare-related case studies in the course. This assignment will likely become part of that aspect of the course.
