



Welcome to Middle School Pride Camp!

July 26-31, 2020

This information letter should be kept for reference. **No other information will be sent prior to your arrival.** Please share this letter with your parent/guardian. You should have received a receipt confirming your payment and any balance due. Balance **MUST** be paid by **June 29, 2020**. You can make your payment online using the payment link on our website, by sending a check written out to UW-Green Bay to the Summer Camps Office, or by calling 920-465-2775 with your credit card.

COMMUTERS:

Campers who will be commuting to campus each day.

- Check-in:** Check-in is between **8:00-8:30am** on **Monday, July 26** in the Mary Ann Cofrin Hall lobby. Please park in the **Visitor's Lot** (See Camp Map-follow the directions for "C").
- Directions:** Enter campus at the Nicolet Entrance onto South Circle Drive and take a left onto Leon Bond Drive. The Mary Ann Cofrin Hall and Visitors Parking lot will be located on the left. Enter Mary Ann Cofrin hall and follow signs to check-in.
- Drop Off/Pick up Policy:** Parents are advised to drop off/pick up your camper promptly at 8:00am and 4:00pm. Staff are on site from 7:45am-4:15pm. Failure to pick up your camper on time will result in a supervisory charge of \$15 per hour. **NOTE:** Green Bay Transit operates to and from campus each day, with drop off locations at the Cofrin Library and Studio Arts Building. Busses run :10 and :40 on the hour. Bus passes are \$2 per day for campers. For more information contact: 920-448-3450 or www.greenbaymetro.com.
- Commuter campers are not allowed in the University Housing area.

RESIDENTS:

Campers who will be staying in campus housing.

- Check-in:** Check-in is outside **Robert Warren Hall** (rain backup: first floor lounge) **3:00-4:00pm** on **Sunday, July 26**. Park in the adjacent parking lot. (See Camp Map-follow the directions for "D"). You will receive your room assignment and directions to your room. Arrival to and departure from the campus is your responsibility; transportation is not provided from bus stations, airports, etc.
- What to Bring:** Toiletries, bedding, and a fan.
- Housing Handbook:** You and your parent/guardian must read the Camp Housing Handbook, which contains camp rules and regulations. It also provides information on what you should bring with you to camp (fan, sheets, towels, etc.).
- Messages:** These can be left 24/7 at the Head Counselor's Office at 920-465-2742.
- Evening/Special Events:** Scheduled for Resident Campers each night from 6:30-9:30pm and may include games, movies, pizza parties, and/or field trips to various attractions around Green Bay. It is recommended that campers bring a minimum of \$50 for the camp store, snacks and activities.
- Check-Out:** Parents/guardians please meet your camper at his/her dorm between **4:00-5:00pm** on **Friday, July 31** to properly check-out with their floor counselor. **Check-out must be completed before 5:00pm Friday.** The Friday dinner meal is not included in your camp fee.

ALL CAMPERS:

- Health Information:** Our camp **Health Forms** are now electronic! You will receive an e-mail closer to camp that will prompt you to fill out your Health Form online. Health Forms must be filled out online before your camper checks in to camp.



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-Meals: Each day campers will eat in the Cloud Commons cafeteria and will have two hot meal options, a full salad bar, and dessert bar. Campers are not allowed to leave campus for meals, or at any other time during the day. **Commuters:** All lunches are included in your camp fees. You are welcome to bring your own lunch, but there is no discount on camp fees.

Residents: Sunday dinner will be the first meal served. Your Resident Counselor will show you where everything is located. Your parents/guardians are welcome to eat with you after Sunday check-in. The cost of each parent meal will be approximately \$8.00. The last meal is Friday lunch.

-Dietary Needs: If your camper has food allergies, or needs alternative meals prepared, please let us know at least two weeks before camp begins at camps@uwgb.edu or 920-465-2775.

-Class Hours: Daily class hours are from 8:00am-4:00pm.

You will be given room and class schedules when you arrive. You may not leave the camp premises without permission from camp personnel at any time during the camp day.

-Parking: Campers who bring a vehicle to camp are required to submit their license plate number at check-in. This will serve as your “parking pass” on campus. Failure to report your plate number will result in a ticket. Do not park in 15-minute or loading zones.

-Camp Dress: University classrooms are air-conditioned, but campus housing is not. TIP: If you can’t wear it to school, you can’t wear it here.
