



Welcome to UW-Green Bay Video Game Programming Camp Level 2! July 20-24, 2020

This information letter should be kept for reference. **No other information will be sent prior to your arrival.** Please share this letter with your parent/guardian. You should have received a receipt confirming your payment and any balance due. Balance **MUST** be paid by **June 22, 2020**. You can make your payment online using the payment link on our website, by sending a check written out to UW-Green Bay to the Summer Camps Office, or by calling 920-465-2775 with your credit card.

Campers:

- Check-in:** Check-in is between **8:00-8:30am** on **Monday, July 20** in the **Wood Hall Lobby**. Please park in the **Wood Hall Parking Lot**. (See Camp Map-follow directions for "A").
- Directions:** Enter campus at the Nicolet Entrance onto South Circle Drive and take the first left onto Wood Hall Drive. This will bring you to the **Wood Hall Parking Lot**. Enter the building and follow signs to check-in.
- Drop Off/Pick up Policy:** Parents are advised to drop off/pick up your camper promptly at 8:30am and 4:00pm. Staff are on site from 8:00am-4:15pm. Failure to pick up your camper on time will result in a supervisory charge of \$15 per hour.
- Health Information:** Our camp **Health Forms** are now electronic! You will receive an e-mail closer to camp that will prompt you to fill out your Health Form online. Health Forms must be filled out online before your camper checks-in to camp.
- Meals:** Each day campers will eat in the Cloud Commons cafeteria and will have two hot meal options, a full salad bar, and dessert bar. Campers are not allowed to leave campus for meals, or at any other time during the day. All lunches are included in your camp fees. You are welcome to bring your own lunch, but there is no discount on camp fees.
- Dietary Needs:** If your camper has food allergies, or needs alternative meals prepared, please let us know at least two weeks before camp begins at camps@uwgb.edu or 920-465-2775.
- Class Hours:** Daily class hours are from 8:30am-4:00pm. Lunch hours are from 12:00-1:00pm. You will be given room and class schedules when you arrive. You may not leave the camp premises without permission from camp personnel at any time during the camp day.
- Dress:** Dress for the weekdays of the camp session should be appropriate, comfortable, summer clothing. Classrooms are air conditioned, but campus housing is not. TIP: If you can't wear it to school, you can't wear it here.
- Flash Drive:** If you would like to save your work to bring home with you, please bring a flash drive with you to camp.
- Parking:** Campers who bring a vehicle to camp are required to submit their license plate number at check-in. This will serve as your "parking pass" on campus. Failure to report your plate number will result in a ticket. Do not park in 15-minute or loading zones.
- Final Day:** On **Friday, July 24** there will be a final presentation beginning at **2:45pm** in **Wood Hall, Room 327**. Family and friends are welcome to attend. Please park in the Wood Hall Parking Lot. The presentation will conclude at 4:00pm.
