Middle Childhood – Early Adolescence (Ages 6-12/13)

A license under this category allows the holder to teach any subject, except a foreign language, in a self-contained classroom; and the categories of Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and Health in a departmentalized or other school organization pattern.

**Prior to Full Admission to the Program:**

- A minimum of 28 university level credits completed.

**Communication Skills Competency (select 1):**

- Pass all three sections of the Praxis CORE  
 An ACT composite score of 23 or higher, with a min. of 20 in English, Math and Reading  
 Earn a “C” or better in approved coursework in Mathematics, English Composition, and English.
