## To apply for summer 2018 financial aid at the University of Wisconsin Colleges, you must:

- submit this application after you have registered for all of your summer 2018 classes in PRISM. Note: processing of Summer 2018 Aid Applications by the Student Financial Aid Office will not begin until April 16.
- 2. have released at www.fafsa.gov your 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) using FAFSA school code 003897 and provided supporting documents (such as Verification documents, if requested) to UW Colleges.
- complete the above a minimum of four weeks before your last summer class ends, allowing time for your summer aid to be processed completely. Late applicants are not guaranteed aid. It is recommended that you do 1 and 2 above by May 11, 2018.
- 4. be admitted as a degree-seeking student and meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress standards at UW Colleges.

## Types of aid available for summer 2018:

- <u>Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Student Loans</u>: must be enrolled for at least 6 credits. For most students, summer 2018 loan eligibility is determined by subtracting Direct Student Loans disbursed during the fall 2017-spring 2018 academic year from the annual limits of: Freshman Dependent: \$5,500 Sophomore Dependent \$6,500 BAAS Dependent: \$7,500 Freshman Independent: \$9,500 Sophomore Independent: \$10,500 BAAS Independent: \$12,500
- Direct Parent PLUS Loan: must be enrolled for at least 6 credits. Only parents of Dependent aid applicants may apply; parent is the borrower and repays the loan. Maximum Direct Parent PLUS eligibility is summer Cost of Attendance minus all other aid.
- Federal Work-Study (FWS): must be enrolled for at least 6 credits. Very limited availability; check with your UW Colleges campus.
- Federal Pell Grant: to receive Pell, (1) must have eligibility remaining from your annual 2017-2018 Pell Grant award, and/or (2) if your annual Pell Grant eligibility was used during fall 2017/spring 2018, you may be eligible for Additional Pell Grant funds for summer if enrolled for at least 6 credits.
  - Remaining 2017-2018 Pell Grant eligibility will be used first. An Additional Pell Grant award for summer will be made only if you initially meet eligibility criteria which includes enrollment in at least 6 summer credits.
  - If awarded Pell from remaining 2017-18 eligibility and you drop a class or fail to initiate course participation, the Pell Grant may be adjusted and result in a bill from UW Colleges if Pell funds already have disbursed to your UWC student account.
  - If awarded Additional Pell Grant funds and you fail to academically participate in the 6 credit minimum, the entire Additional Pell Grant award will be canceled even if already disbursed to your UWC student account. This will result in your owing
