**WHEREAS**, the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay Student Government Association represents the 5,800 enrolled students of the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay, and

**WHEREAS**, we share the belief that students should not be punished academically for their conduct outside of the academic setting, and

**WHEREAS**, UW-Milwaukee administration has proposed changes in UWS 17 Nonacademic Misconduct policy that would academically punish students for non-Academic behavior taking place beyond the boundaries of the UWM campus, and

**WHEREAS**, punishing students academically for conduct in which they have already received civil and/or criminal punishment outside of the University setting is a clear violation of double-jeopardy, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Student Association oppose proposed changes to UWS 17, Nonacademic Misconduct policy, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution be forwarded to the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Student Association to be sent to the Board of Regents and UW System President accompanied by identical legislation from other UW System campuses.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that this resolution be forwarded to UW-Green Bay administration.
