- 12:00 AM was chosen as the least desirable option 0.54% of responses.
- 1:00 AM was ranked the most preferred option in 64.97% of the responses.
- 10:00 PM was the least preferred option in 88.59% of the responses.
- The 484 students who ranked 1:00 AM as most preferred outnumber the combination of students who Opposed (180) and had No Opinion (202). 382 added together.
- Also, 1:00 AM was ranked most preferred more than twice 12:00 AM. 64.97% to 30.07%, respectively.

- There was confusion among the students about the meaning of 1 year, 2 year, 3 year, 4 year, and 5+ years.
- The question should have read: What year is this living on-campus for you?
- The selection should have read: First year; Second year; Third year; Fourth year; Fifth year or longer. This was the intended meaning.
- It is likely many sophomores answered 1 year.
- This and the housing questions were auxiliary to provide some context to the answers. I would rely more on the question regarding Apartment vs. Residence Hall when analyzing.
